2024 SS4A Awards

On November 15, 2024, the [U.S. Department of Transportation announced](#) 257 fiscal year (FY) 2024 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant awards totaling \$172 million to local, regional, and Tribal communities.

This is the third and final award announcement for FY 2024. Combined, **710 communities have received over \$1.2 billion as part of the FY 2024 funding round.**

These awards include 640 Planning and Demonstration Grant awards totaling \$434,890,481 and 70 Implementation Grant awards totaling \$806,600,340, shown in the map below.
