partisan Infrastructure Law summary: "For an additional amount for Pacific Coastal lmon Recovery through a competitive grant program for states and tribes to protect, nserve, and restore salmon and steelhead populations and their habitats."

ne objective of the Pacific Coastal Salmon Recovery Fund (PCSRF) is to supplement isting state and tribal programs for salmon and steelhead restoration and nservation. The goal is to reverse the declines of Pacific salmon and steelhead, pporting conservation efforts in California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, and Alaska. SRF supports activities that implement climate adaptation and resilience solutions, cluding those associated with both natural (land, water, coasts, oceans) and iman/built systems (e.g., transportation, communication, and infrastructure), with the al of improving the ability of these systems to anticipate, respond to, withstand, or cover from acute or gradual climate change impacts.

DAA Fisheries will seek applications through a competitive PCSRF grant competition r projects from eligible applicants - the states of Washington, Oregon, Idaho, evada, California, and Alaska, and Federally recognized tribes of the Columbia River d Pacific Coast (including Alaska).
