Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund Award Obligation Update

As of August 16, 2024, EPA has obligated the full \$27 billion of Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund awards to selected recipients under the National Clean Investment Fund (NCIF), Clean Communities Investment Accelerator (CCIA), and the Solar for All grant competitions. EPA has notified all grant recipients of the obligation of their awards. Full disbursement of these funds is subject to the resolution of all disputes under the Greenhouse Gas Reduction Fund grant competitions.
