## **Building Performance Standards**

Building Performance Standards (BPS) are performance-based standards aimed at reducing energy use and operational costs in existing buildings and improving overall comfort, durability, and resilience for building occupants by setting targets for energy or other performance metrics.




Figure 1. The BPS map highlights the current status of BPS adoption at the state and local level across the U.S.
